



CAFI Executive Board Decision

Regional

Extension with additional budget of Regional Technical Assistance Facility implemented by UNOPS – [\[00140486\]](#)

Considering:

- Decision [EB.2023.05](#) adopted on 18 April 2023 approving the development of a project document for the creation of a regional technical assistance facility to provide technical assistance and capacity building to CAFI partner countries ;
- Decision [EB.2023.29](#) adopted on 27 November 2023 on the approval of the UNOPS Regional Technical Assistance Facility of 10,000,000 USD ;
- Decision [EB.2024.11](#) adopted on 23 April 2024 on the approval of the revised Regional Technical Facility PRODOC ;
- Decision [EB.2026.07](#) on the extension with additional budget, 7,000,000 USD, of the Regional Technical Facility;

The Executive Board:

1. Requests that future tranches be disbursed upon demonstration of financial need and subject to the exclusive application of a 3.88% indirect cost rate across the entire project financing. As approved in the Decision [EB.2026.07](#) pertaining to the cost extension of the project for 37 months, until 31/12/2029, and 7 million USD.
2. Requests UNOPS to proceed with the extension of the project as approved by the CAFI Executive Board, as well as with the extension of the relevant contracts, as applicable.
3. Recalls that, while respecting its rules and regulations, the implementing organization commits to apply zero tolerance towards fraud, corruption, sexual exploitation and abuse; to protect whistleblowers; to inform the public; to promote gender equality and social inclusion; and to use appropriate complaint mechanisms. In addition, the implementing organization commits to carefully managing all other contextual and programmatic risks identified by the Board and should act proactively in reporting these risks to CAFI's Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office, in accordance with the Terms of Reference of CAFI's Trust Fund.

4. Recalls that the implementing organization will have to report on progress towards the indicators of CAFI's Results Framework in accordance with CAFI's guidelines and templates. In addition, the implementing organization will have to provide CAFI with all reports and data (raw and analysed) from household surveys and other field studies including spatial information (i.e. GPS coordinates), as well as information on how its activities address and respect CAFI's social and environmental safeguards requirements.
5. Reminds the implementing organization of its reporting obligations under the current CAFI Operations Manual, in terms of both narrative and financial reports.
6. Instructs the CAFI Secretariat to sign the project document for the extension with additional budget on its behalf.
