

# Annual report and M&E Framework

## Adopted at EB 16 on 25 June 2020

#### EB.2020.08

### In light of

- the preliminary CAFI 2019 Annual Consolidated report submitted to the MPTF-O on 31 May 2020;
- decision EB.2018.08, allowing submission of the CAFI Consolidated report to be extended to the 30<sup>th</sup> of June of each year in order to take into account competing deadlines;
- decision EB.2019.14 setting a target to ensure that at least 15% of programmes assessed as gender responsive,

## the Executive Board

- adopts the CAFI 2019 Consolidated Annual report, dated 31 May 2020
- recommends that the following is considered in this or the next reporting cycles
  - o links to all programme reports and products
  - qualitative criteria to evaluate gender considerations are integrated, including within the programming and designing phases of interventions
- <u>notes</u> that the gender target has been met, with 17 % of programmes assessed as gender responsive and decides to set the following new targets for the next reporting cycle:
  - at least 30 % of programmes are gender-responsive (4 out of 4 criteria)
  - o another 20% (at least) of gender sensitive programmes meet 3 out of 4 criteria:
- <u>commits</u> to increase its oversight on gender in new programmes and reporting of existing programmes
- <u>encourages</u> implementing agencies to ensure a vigorous approach to gender responsiveness and reporting and <u>asks</u> the CAFI Secretariat to propose guidance on such reporting
- <u>asks</u> the CAFI Secretariat to
  - prioritize the collection of perception-based indicators to complement existing datasets
  - propose an amendment of the M&E framework to reflect the impact of the oil sector on forests
  - o explore ways to capture the policy dialogue and influence aspects of CAFI's work
